1 IN RESPECT OF OWEN POWELL

A4137 traffic related concerns – a further accident has occurred on 21 July 2026 involving a HGV. The meeting was minded of a recent meeting with HC roads engineers, residents and representing the parish council R Mutlow and M Wigmore. Several action elements were raised (reference various related correspondence) to determine what improvements could be made to increase the safety levels.
